

THE STIPENDS ORDINANCE 1980

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the fixing of the Stipend and Allowances of the Bishop and the minimum stipends and allowances payable to members of the clergy.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the fixing of the Stipend and Allowances of the Bishop and the Administrator and the minimum stipends and allowances payable to members of the clergy NOW THE SYNOD HEREBY DETERMINES:

Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Stipends Ordinance 1980".

The Bishop

2. (1) The Bishop shall be paid such stipend and allowances as the Diocesan Council shall from time to time determine.

(2) There shall be paid to the account of the Bishop in such superannuation fund providing benefits upon death or retirement as the Bishop and the Diocesan Council may agree such annual amount as the Diocesan Council shall from time to time determine.

(3) The amounts payable pursuant to this section insofar as they are not provided by other funds for the purpose shall be Diocesan Expenses for the purposes of The Assessment Ordinance 1980.

The Administrator

3. (1) The Administrator shall be paid such stipend and allowances as the Diocesan Council shall from time to time determine.

(2) The amounts payable pursuant to this section insofar as they are not provided by other funds for the purpose shall be Diocesan Expenses for the purposes of The Assessment Ordinance 1980.

Members of the Clergy

4. (1) Subject to any directions in that behalf given by the Synod the minimum stipend and allowances payable to members of the clergy shall be such amounts as the Diocesan Council shall from time to time determine.

(2) The minimum stipends and allowances fixed pursuant to subsection (1) of this section maybe fixed at different rates for deacons, assistant members of the clergy and other members of the clergy.
